

**Failure to Report Initial Inventory to the State**  
**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER**  
**Reporting Requirement(s) Not Met for**  
**Public Water Supply District #1 of Jasper County Missouri.**

We were required to develop and submit to the State an initial service line inventory that includes all service lines connected to the public water distribution system and characterize the materials of those service lines as either lead, galvanized requiring replacement, non-lead, or lead status unknown. Our system submitted an initial inventory of service lines to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources before October 16, 2024.

**We developed the initial inventory and notified people at service connections with service lines made of lead, galvanized, or unknown materials on December 14, 2024.**

Although the failure to report the initial inventory to the State does not create a risk to public health, we are required to inform you of this violation and provide additional information including what we did to correct the situation.

**What should I do?**

There is nothing you need to do currently. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions. Remember, boiling water does not remove lead from water.
